The seminar will begin with a general introduction of the MCP including the different core components; the Maritime Identity Registry, The Maritime Service Registry and the Maritime Messaging Service (MMS) - and the most recent addition to the family - the decentralized trust system.

After the general introduction, a more in-depth presentation of the MMS will be given.

The MMS allows authorized maritime stakeholders to send and receive authenticated/authorized messages in an efficient, reliable and seamless manner to solve problems of the current maritime wireless data communication systems. It is the intention to include demonstrations of the use of MMS both over VDES and plain internet connection.
